INTRODUCTION



Congratulations on qualifying for the Sunshine Tour Championship 2009, we hope that you have enjoyed taking part in the qualifiers and are excited about participating in the Championships.

Our aim is to put on a fun and thrilling championship show, with classes to suit everyone, professionally run to the highest standards possible whilst maintaining a friendly, inclusive atmosphere and with exciting championship titles and prizes to be won.

This championship is for:
Unaffiliated and amateur riders
Unaffiliated horses

The spirit of this competition as an amateur & unaffiliated championship is very important to us as organisers, to our sponsors and to our competitors, so we request that all participants respect the spirit of restrictions, not necessarily just the letter of the law. In some cases unaffiliated riders and/or horses can have dabbled or lightly competed in affiliated competition. Young or very green horses can be ridden by someone who is semi-professional (see below for our interpretation of 'professional' rider). Please carefully read restriction notes with class information. We have tried very hard to keep entry restrictions relevant and realistic, but if you are in doubt about whether you are genuinely eligible to compete or which section you should compete in, please contact Sunshine Tour HQ for clarification.

As part of our commitment to provide classes for all, we have expanded the championship classes on offer this year and the competition will be run over 2 days. Saturday classes are 'Small Tour' especially for more novice/inexperienced horses and riders (and Saturday includes all showing championships) and Sunday classes are 'Grand Tour' for more experienced/competitive combinations. In some cases this might mean that you have more than one class to choose from, relevant to your original qualification so please read the schedule carefully before selecting the right class for you and your horse to take part in. Please note that the same horse/rider combination cannot compete in both Small and Grand Tour classes or more than 3 classes within one discipline. However, you can compete in more than one discipline on the same or different days.

If you find that you are overqualified for the class that you originally qualified in, either because of restrictions or because you are now competing at a higher level then you might still be able to take part in the championship because you can voluntarily exchange your qualification ticket for a higher level class. E.g. in dressage if you qualify in Prelim you could voluntarily upgrade to Novice, or in show jumping if you qualify in 2'3" then you could upgrade to 2'6".

Thank you for taking part in the Sunshine Tour Championship Series 2009. We look forward to seeing you for a fun and exciting weekend in September. Good luck to everyone!

'Professional' Rider (according to Sunshine Tour) is someone who makes some or all of their living from:

- Riding, training, schooling or competing horses/ponies, either their own or belonging to others.
- Buying and/or selling or breaking in horses.
- Teaching and/or training riders.

We accept that some genuinely amateur riders might sometimes teach a rider, help a friend by riding their horse or occasionally buy a horse to sell on, or assist in breaking in. However, if you participate in any of these activities on a regular basis please respect the amateur nature of this championship by only competing very green/young horses.

Small Tour Championships are for novice/inexperienced riders and/or novice/young horses, experienced combinations should enter the Grand Tour Championships. N.B. Same horse/rider combination cannot compete in both Small & Grand Tour Dressage Championships.

PRIZES: Championship Winners: Localrider Magazine embroidered rug or jacket, sash, trophy and fabulous championship rosette. Runners up: Sunshine Tour embroidered saddle cloth, sash & rosette. Championship rosettes to 10th place. Small Tour Supreme Champion: see back cover for details of fantastic prizes on offer. Warm Up/Open classes: Rosettes according to entries at 1 per 5 starters.

RULES: British Dressage rules. **No callers or whips allowed in the championship dressage classes.**

NOTE: Those selected to go forward to Championship Ride Off should be prepared to be at the show for a considerable time!

WARM UP / OPEN CLASSES

Results for warm up/open classes might not be issued on the day in order to give Championship classes precedence.

Class 1 Intro/Walk & Trot Dressage Warm Up/Open

Open to any competitor, no pre-qualification required. If class becomes full, priority will be given to Sunshine Tour Dressage competitors. Dressage Test: GBEC W&T 3

Class 2 Prelim Dressage Warm Up/Open

Open to any competitor, no pre-qualification required. If class becomes full, priority given to Sunshine Tour Dressage competitors. Dressage Test: Prelim 10

Class 3 Novice Dressage Warm Up/Open

Open to any competitor, no pre-qualification required. If class becomes full, priority given to Sunshine Tour Dressage competitors. Dressage Test: Novice 20

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Class 4 Sunshine Tour Intro 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in an Intro/Walk & Trot qualifying class during 2009. Riders placed 1st-3rd go forward to Championship Ride Off. Restrictions: Horses/ponies - not to have earned any BD or BE points. Riders - not above BD Group 8, not to have earned any BE points. Dressage Test: BD Intro A

Class 5 Sunshine Tour Prelim 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a Prelim qualifying class during 2009. Riders placed 1st-3rd go forward to Championship Ride Off. Restrictions: Horses/ponies - not to have earned any BD or BE points. Riders - not above BD Group 8, not to have earned any BE points. Dressage Test: Prelim 13

Class 6 Sunshine Tour Novice 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a Novice qualifying class during 2009. Riders placed 1st-3rd go forward to Championship Ride Off. Restrictions: Horses/ponies - not to have earned more than 20 BD or 10 BE points. Riders - not above BD Group 8, not to have competed at BE Novice /above. Dressage Test: Novice 32

SUNSHINE TOUR 'SMALL TOUR' DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

Riders placed 1st-3rd in classes 4, 5 & 6 will each ride their respective test in the Championship Ride Off for the title of "Sunshine Tour 'Small Tour' Dressage Champion" (awarded on percentage) and a **Supreme Championship Prize** - see back cover for details of prizes on offer



SMALL TOUR SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP

Small Tour Championships are for novice/inexperienced riders and/or novice/young horses, experienced combinations should enter the Grand Tour Championships. N.B. Same horse/rider combination cannot compete in both Small & Grand Tour Show Jumping Championships. Horse/rider combination can compete in maximum of 3 show jumping classes.

PRIZES: Championship Winners: Localrider Magazine embroidered rug or jacket, sash, trophy and fabulous championship rosette. Runners up: Sunshine Tour embroidered saddle cloth, sash & rosette. Championship rosettes to 10th place. Small Tour Supreme Champions: see back cover for details of fantastic prizes on offer.

RULES: BSJA rules.

CLASS TIMES: All show jumping competitors are allocated start times. For Saturday show jumping times phone 01372 451458 on Wednesday 23rd September from 2 - 6 pm or check www.gb.ec.info from 6.30 pm onwards.

RESTRICTIONS: Minimus Classes Horses/ponies - not to have won any prize money in BSJA, not to have earned any BE points. Not to have won any unaffiliated classes at 2'3" or above. Riders - not to have ridden any horse/pony in BSJA competitions or any BE events or in Pony Club Area or Championship level show jumping or eventing.

Class 7 Sunshine Tour Minimus 1'6"/45cm 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 1'6"/45cm (or lower) show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Minimus Championship jump off.

Class 8 Sunshine Tour Minimus 1'9"/50cm 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 1'9"/50cm show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Minimus Championship jump off.

SUNSHINE TOUR MINIMUS 'SMALL TOUR' CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS Riders placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in classes 7 & 8 jump off at their respective jump height against the clock for title of "Sunshine Tour Minimus 'Small Tour' Champion" and a **Supreme Championship Prize** - see back cover for details of prizes on offer.

RESTRICTIONS: Novice Classes Horses/ponies - not to have won any prize money in BSJA, not to have earned any BE points. Not to have won any unaffiliated classes at 2'9" or above. Riders - not to have ridden any horse/pony in BSJA competitions or any BE events except on a day ticket, or in Pony Club Area or Championship level show jumping or eventing.

Class 9 Sunshine Tour Novice 2'60cm 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 2'60cm show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Novice Championship jump off.

Class 10 Sunshine Tour Novice 2'3"/70cm 'Small Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 2'3"/70cm show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Novice Championship jump off.

SUNSHINE TOUR NOVICE 'SMALL TOUR' CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS Riders placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in classes 9 & 10 jump off at their respective jump height against the clock for title of "Sunshine Tour Novice 'Small Tour' Champion" and a **Supreme Championship Prize** - see back cover for details of prizes on offer.

WANT TO WARM UP FOR JUMPING? Open to all riders (but if busy competitors taking part in a Sunshine Tour Championship jumping class (show jumping or working hunter / working hunter pony) will be given priority).

CLEAR ROUND

Morning: 1'6"/45cm - 1'9"/50cm

Afternoon: 2'60cm - 2'3"/70cm

Entry fee: £5 per round. Enter at ringside.

PRIZES: Championship Winners: Localrider Magazine embroidered rug or jacket, sash, trophy and fabulous championship rosette. Runners up: Sunshine Tour embroidered saddle cloth, sash & rosette. Championship rosettes to 10th place. Supreme Champions: see back cover for details of the fantastic prizes on offer.

CLASS TIMES: in order to give competitors guidance on timings, start times for each class will be published after entries close. Times for the start of each class will be available on Tuesday 22nd September on 01372 451458 from 2 - 6 pm or www.gb.ec.info from 6.30 pm onwards.

PLEASE NOTE: showing classes are run in more than one ring so class list given here is no indication of running order. Those selected to go forward to Supreme Championships should be prepared to be at the show for a considerable time!

RESTRICTIONS Applicable to all showing competitors: Horse/pony cannot have been placed in any affiliated showing class, e.g. BSPS, SHB, Ponies UK, NPS. Horses/ponies can have taken part in preliminary rounds of affiliated classes that do not require prior membership, e.g. VHS, CHAPS, but must not have taken part in secondary rounds. Riders: Must never have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any affiliated showing class.

IN-HAND CLASSES

Class 11 Sunshine Tour Junior Handler Championship

Open to junior handlers and horses/ponies of any height/type previously qualified in a Junior In-Hand showing class during 2009. To be judged on the handler showing off their horse/pony in-hand, including at halt, walk and a trot up. Handlers to be under 12 years on 26th September 2009. All handlers should wear a hard hat and safe footwear. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour In-Hand Showing Championship.

Class 12 Sunshine Tour In-Hand Championship - Ponies

Open to novice handlers and ponies not exceeding 14.2hh previously qualified in an In-Hand showing class during 2009. Class will include each pony being inspected by the judge at halt, walk and trot. All handlers should wear a hard hat and safe footwear. Judging will be on conformation, straightness of action, manners, condition and neatness of presentation. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour In-Hand Showing Championship.

Class 13 Sunshine Tour In-Hand Championship - Horses

Open to novice handlers and horses exceeding 14.2hh previously qualified in an In-Hand showing class during 2009. Class will include each horse being inspected by the judge at halt, walk and trot. All handlers should wear a hard hat and safe footwear. Judging will be on conformation, straightness of action, manners, condition and neatness of presentation. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour In-Hand Showing Championship.

SUNSHINE TOUR IN-HAND SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS 1st & 2nd placed in classes 11, 12 & 13 return for final judging for title of "Sunshine Tour In-Hand Showing Champion" and a **Supreme Championship Prize** - see back cover for details of prizes on offer.

RIDDEN CLASSES

Class 14 Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship - Lead Rein

Open to riders under 11 years old on 26th September 2009 and horses/ponies of any height/type previously qualified in a Lead Rein ridden showing class during 2009. Will not be required to canter or jump. Snaffle bridles only, lead rein should be attached to noseband. Blemishes will not be penalised. Judging will be influenced by paces, conformation, manners, suitability, condition and neatness of presentation. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship.

Showing Championships Continued

Class 15 Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship - Junior

Open to riders under 15 years on 26th September 2009 and horses/ponies of any height/type previously qualified in a ridden showing class during 2009. Class will include all horses being seen at walk, trot and canter, and each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show. Trot up section is at judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised, plain tack and snaffle bridles are encouraged and martingales are not allowed. Judging will be on paces, conformation, action, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. If sufficient entries, class will be split into horses and ponies. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship.

Class 16 Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship - Open

Open to novice show riders and horses/ponies any height/type previously qualified in a ridden showing class during 2009. Class will include all horses being seen at walk, trot and canter, and each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show. Trot up section / judge riding is at judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised, plain tack and snaffle bridles are encouraged and martingales are not allowed. Judging will be on paces, conformation, action, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. If sufficient entries, class will be split into horses and ponies. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship.

Class 17 Sunshine Tour Working Hunter Pony Championship

Open to novice show riders and ponies not exceeding 14.2hh of any type/breed previously qualified in a working hunter pony class during 2009. Ponies not exceeding 13.2hh - jumps approx. 1'9". Ponies exceeding 13.2hh but not exceeding 14.2hh - jumps approx. 2'. Open to riders any age. Each section will jump, then both sections return to the ring together for show judging. To be judged: 60% jumping, 40% individual show and conformation. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship.

Class 18 Sunshine Tour Working Hunter Championship

Open to novice show riders and horses exceeding 14.2hh of any type/breed previously qualified in a working hunter class during 2009. Horses not exceeding 15.2hh - jumps approx. 2'3". Horses exceeding 15.2hh - jumps approx. 2'6". Open to riders any age. Each section will jump then, both sections return to the ring together for show judging. To be judged: 60% jumping, 40% ride and conformation. 1st & 2nd go forward to Sunshine Tour Ridden Showing Championship.

Class 22 Sunshine Tour Novice 'Grand Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a Novice dressage test qualifier class during 2009. Riders placed 1st-3rd go forward to Championship Ride Off. Restrictions: Horses/ponies - not to have earned more than 40 BD or 20 BE points. Riders - not above BD Group 7, not to have competed at BE Open Novice or above. Dressage Test: Novice 34

Class 23 Sunshine Tour Elementary 'Grand Tour' Championship

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in an Elementary dressage test qualifier class during 2009. Riders placed 1st-3rd go forward to Championship Ride Off. Restrictions: Horses/ponies - not to have earned more than 50 BD or 30 BE points. Riders - not above BD Group 6, not to have competed at BE Intermediate or above. Dressage Test: Elem 49

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 2'3"/70cm show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Small Open Championship jump off.

For competitors previously qualified by being placed 1st-6th in a 3'-3'3"/90cm-1m show jumping qualifier class during 2009. All clears or best 10 go forward to jump off against clock. 1st, 2nd & 3rd go forward to Open Championship jump off.

SUNSHINE TOUR OPEN 'GRAND TOUR' CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS Riders placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in classes 26 & 27 jump off at their respective jump height against the clock for title of "Sunshine Tour Open 'Grand Tour' Champion" and a **Supreme Championship Prize** - see back cover for details of prizes on offer.

Warm up/Open classes from 2'3" to 3'3" are open to any competitor. If classes become full, priority will be given to Sunshine Tour Championship Show Jumping competitors. Prizes: Rosettes according to entries at 1 per 5 starters.



SUNSHINE TOUR CHAMPIONSHIPS GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The organisers of this events have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must themselves take all reasonable precautions to avoid/prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers/instructors.
- Great Bookham Equestrian Centre, the organisers, their representatives or helpers do not accept liability for injury, damage or loss suffered by spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends, vehicles or property however caused and under any circumstances except proven negligence of the organisers.
- Participants, or their parents/guardians if rider is under 18 years, must consider themselves competent to complete the activity for which they are entering. It is not the responsibility of the organisers to decide if a competitor is competent or their mount is suitable for the class. If the judge deems any rider or horse to be unsuitable / unsafe to participate they will be asked to leave immediately and no refund will be given.
- To be eligible to compete in any championship class, entrant must provide proof of qualification acquired during 2009. Correct entry fee must be received to be eligible to compete/participate.
- Riders who qualify for 4 or more levels of championship classes in the same discipline, can only compete in 3. These must be consecutive and cannot include the lowest level qualified for. The same horse/rider combination cannot take part in Small Tour and Grand Tour within the same discipline.
- Absolutely no substitutions of horse or rider allowed in any championship class.
- Sunshine Tour uses expert judges. Their decision is to be respected and is final. Any objections about conduct of classes must be brought to the organiser's attention on the day of competition and we will make every effort to resolve problems. Formal objections should be lodged with the secretary within 30 minutes of the incident and supported by a £20 deposit.
- Veterinary—Mayes & Scrine Equine Veterinary Practice are on call. Farriery—no farrier is on site or specifically on call for this event.
- Hard hats Correctly fitting riding hat complying with current safety standards, and safe footwear must be worn whilst mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended for show jumping.
- Horses must be 4 years old or over to be eligible to compete in ridden classes. Animals deemed to be sick or lame will not be allowed to compete or be ridden on the showground and a refund will not be given. Stallions are welcome provided they are displaying appropriate tail ribbons, are well behaved and not causing a nuisance or danger to other competitors or their horses.
- We reserve the right to cancel or alter any part or the whole of the schedule at any time.
- Prizes stated in the schedule are subject to change, alteration or substitution. Some prizes require collection from GBEC at a later date. In the event of insufficient entries some prizes will be withheld.
- A vet's or doctor's certificate will be required for a refund of entry fees. No exceptions to this rule.
- Bad weather—If weather or ground conditions are poor it is the responsibility of competitors to confirm that the event is running by ringing 01372 451458 the evening before or morning of the competition. Every effort will be made to re-schedule, but in the event of the competition being cancelled, entry fees minus a small administration charge will be returned to competitors.
- All dogs *must* be kept on a lead at all times. Owners who allow their dogs to run loose on the showground will be required to remove them from the premises immediately.
