DRESSAGE QUALIFIER CLASSES

1st - 4th PLACE QUALIFIES. Qualification CANNOT go down the line.

Riders can qualify in open or restricted classes & select relevant section according to restrictions when registering.

Intro Dressage

BD Intro or centre's own Walk & Trot classes

Pony Club or Riding Club tests restricted to walk and trot

Novice Dressage

BD Novice tests

Pony Club Intermediate or Riding Club Novice

Prelim Dressage

BD Prelim tests

Pony Club Novice or Riding Club Prelim

Elementary Dressage

BD Elementary tests

Pony Club Open or Riding Club Advanced

Junior Dressage

Junior classes or junior riders taking part in Intro, Prelim, Novice and Elementary classes

Not eligible..... Teams, training classes, clinics, quadrilles or 'virtual' competitions.

EVENTERS CHALLENGE QUALIFIER CLASSES

1st - 6th PLACE QUALIFIES. Qualification CANNOT go down the line.

Combined show jumping and cross country style competition. Cross country section can be knock down or fixed, against clock or optimum time. Qualifying competitions can be held on surface or grass.

SHOWING QUALIFIER CLASSES

1st - 6th PLACE QUALIFIES. Qualification cannot go down the line.

QUALIFIER CLASSES

Qualifier classes can be open or restricted – competitors select relevant class according to the restrictions applicable to their class when registering. Junior qualifiers must comply with championship age restrictions at the time of the championship.

Fun Showing Classes

Novelty and Fun showing classes: e.g. Prettiest Mare, Handsomest Gelding, Judge's Choice etc, etc
Classes based on turnout, neatness, presentation, encouraging participation etc (not necessarily judged on performance/ individual show / paces/ breed/ conformation). Ridden ponies, ridden horses, in-hand ponies, in-hand horses (or mixed) and lead rein classes. If in doubt about the eligibility of your class, please check with Sunshine Tour HQ.

Turnout Classes

Condition & Turnout classes – ridden & in-hand & lead rein.

Novice, Newcomer & Restricted Classes (but not training classes)

Ridden classes for horses or ponies or mixed heights - novice, introductory or restricted classes
In-Hand classes for horses or ponies or mixed heights - novice, introductory or restricted classes
Junior Handler or Child Handler classes

Introduction to Showing, Guided Showing, Set Pattern, Walk & Trot classes

Ridden classes for horses or ponies or mixed heights - strictly for novices.

Lead Rein & First Ridden

Lead Rein classes – 6 years and under, 10 years and under or mixed age classes
Lead Rein M&M classes – 6 years and under, 10 years and under or mixed age classes
First Ridden classes – 12 years and under
First Ridden M&M classes - 12 years and under

Junior Rider

Best Rider, Junior Best Rider – 12 years and under, 16 years and under or mixed age classes
Equitation, Junior Equitation - 12 years and under, 16 years and under or mixed age classes

Pony Club, Riding Club, All-Rounder, Family Horse & Pony

Pony Club Pony or Riding Club Pony
Riding Club Horse or All-Rounder Horse
Family or Versatile Pony
Family or Versatile Horse
Handy Pony or Handy Horse

Veteran Horse & Pony

Ridden Veteran, Senior or 15+ horse or pony – can be split into age groups or mixed ages

In-Hand Veteran, Senior or 15+ horse or pony – can be split into age groups or mixed ages
Lead Rein Veteran, Senior or 15+ horse or pony

In-Hand Show Horse & Show Pony

Cobs and Maxi Cobs – in-hand classes, can be separate or mixed height classes
Show Horse classes – in-hand, can be separate breed/height classes or mixed
Show Hunter classes – in-hand, can be divided into small and large horses or mixed
Mountain and Moorland or Native – in-hand, can be divided into small and large breed or mixed
Coloured, Odd Coloured and Piebald & Skewbald – in-hand horse or pony or mixed height classes
Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony - in-hand show pony or show hunter pony or mixed type classes

Ridden Show Horse & Show Pony

Cobs and Maxi Cobs – ridden classes, can be separate or mixed height classes
Riding Horse and Hack classes – can be separate type/height classes or mixed
Show Hunter & Ridden Hunter classes – can be divided into small and large horses or mixed
Mountain and Moorland or Native – ridden, can be divided into small and large breed or mixed
Coloured, Odd Coloured and Piebald & SI Coloured, Odd Co Coloured, Odd Coloured and Piebald
& Skewbald – ridden horse or pony or mixed
Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony - ridden show pony or show hunter pony or mixed type classes

Working Hunter, Working Show Horse/Cob & Working Hunter Pony

Working Hunter – can be split by height or mixed height 14.2hh / 148cm and over
Working Show Horse or Working Cob
Working Hunter Pony – can be split by height or mixed height up to 15hh / 153cm
M&M Working Hunter Pony – can be split into small and large breeds or mixed
