

# 2024 Sunshine Tour Championships



# **COMPETITOR & HORSE/PONY RESTRICTIONS**

**Sunshine Tour Championships are for AMATEUR competitors,** professionals are excluded from competing in the Sunshine Tour. **Our definition of a 'professional' is someone who earns money from:** 

- 1. Training, schooling, breaking, producing for competition or sale, or competing horses/ponies for clients, owners or a business.
  - People who work with horses solely for care, e.g. grooms, vet nurses and only participate in exercising of horses, e.g. hacking & lunging for exercise but <u>not</u> schooling, training, competing or breaking client's horses can qualify.
- 2. Buying, selling or breeding horses for sale or profit.
- 3. Teaching and/or training riders.
  - o Instructors who <u>only</u> teach in a riding school with riding school horses/ponies and do not teach people on their own horses can qualify.
- 4. Judging affiliated classes in the same discipline as your competition (paid or unpaid).

# DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Each Dressage Qualification Number allows you to enter one dressage championship class:

At the same level as your qualification test **OR** above your qualification test level.

Horse/rider combinations can compete in 6 dressage championships, over 2 levels (Levels are: Intro, Prelim, Novice, Elementary) which must be consecutive. For example: if you've qualified for Intro, Prelim and Novice, you can compete in Prelim & Novice championships, but not Intro & Novice. Warm up classes can cover 3 levels.

You DO NOT have to compete in the SAME TEST as your qualification, only the same LEVEL or above.

**TOURS** are just groups of classes, divided by competence and measurable points/winnings restrictions - please respect the spirit of each level as well as the letter of the law. If you are outside the restrictions for the level that you qualified in, you can voluntarily move up to compete in a higher level.

# **RESTRICTIONS**

# **SMALL TOUR**

Horse/Pony (with any rider): Not to have earned more than 20 BD points, with none earned at Novice level or above. If horse/pony has more points than permitted, but NONE earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Rider (with any horse):** Not to have earned any points at BD Novice level or above; not to have competed at BE Novice. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

**Combination:** BD Intro Bronze restrictions apply.

# **GRAND TOUR**

Horse/Pony (with any rider): Not to have earned more than 50 BD points, with none earned at Elementary level or above. If horse/pony has more points than permitted, but NONE earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Rider (with any horse):** Not to have earned any points at BD Elementary level or above; not to have competed at BE Intermediate or above. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

**Combination:** BD Prelim Bronze restrictions apply.

# SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS

# Each Show Jumping Qualification Number allows you to enter ONE show jumping championship class:

At the same height as qualification **OR** above your qualification height **OR** 5cm below your qualification. Horse/rider combination can take part in a maximum of 6 show jumping championships which must not be more than 20cm difference from lowest class to highest.

**TOURS** are just groups of classes, divided by competence and measurable points/winnings restrictions - please respect the spirit of each level as well as the letter of the law. If you are outside the restrictions for the height that you qualified in, you can voluntarily move up to compete in a higher level.

#### MINI TOUR - 30cm to 45cm

Mini Tour classes are for very novice/inexperienced riders. Riders competing at 70cm or above (on any horse/pony) should enter the Small Tour instead.

**Pony (with any rider) not to have earned more than 30 BS points.** If pony has more than overall points permitted, but none earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Riders (on any horse/pony)** competing at 70cm or above in any official British Showjumping or British Eventing competitions, or in Area, Regional or Championship Pony Club or Riding Club competitions should enter the Small Tour instead. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

Combination cannot compete in Small, Grand or Trophy Tour show jumping or Small or Grand Tour eventers challenge.

#### SMALL TOUR - 50cm to 75cm

Horse/Pony (with any rider) not to have earned more than 60 BS points. If horse/pony has more than overall points permitted, but none earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Riders (on any horse/pony)** competing at 90cm or above in any official British Showjumping or British Eventing competitions, or in Area, Regional or Championship Pony Club or Riding Club competitions should enter the Grand Tour instead. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

Combination: cannot compete in Mini Tour show jumping.

#### GRAND TOUR - 80cm to 1.0m

Horse/Pony (with any rider) not to have earned more than 90 BS points or any British Eventing points; Foundation points are permissible. If horse/pony has more than overall points permitted, but none earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Riders (on any horse/pony)** competing at 1.10m or above in any official British Showjumping or British Eventing competitions, or in Area, Regional or Championship Pony Club or Riding Club competitions are not eligible. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

Combination cannot compete in Mini Tour show jumping.

#### **EVENTERS CHALLENGE CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Each Eventers Challenge Qualification Number allows you to enter ONE eventers challenge championship class: At the same height as qualification OR above your qualification height OR 5cm below your qualification.

Horse/rider combination can take part in a maximum of 3 eventers challenge championships which must not be more than 20cm difference from lowest class to highest.

**TOURS** are just groups of classes, divided by competence and measurable points/winnings restrictions - please respect the spirit of each level as well as the letter of the law. If you are outside the restrictions for the level that you qualified in, you can voluntarily move up to compete in a higher level.

#### SMALL TOUR - 50cm to 75cm

Horse/Pony (with any rider) not to have earned more than 60 BS points. If horse/pony has more than overall points permitted, but none earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Riders (on any horse/pony)** competing at 90cm or above in any official British Showjumping or British Eventing competitions, or in Area, Regional or Championship Pony Club or Riding Club competitions should enter the Grand Tour instead. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

Combination: cannot compete in Mini Tour show jumping.

#### GRAND TOUR - 80cm to 90cm

Horse/Pony (with any rider) not to have earned more than 90 BS points or any British Eventing points; Foundation points are permissible. If horse/pony has more than overall points permitted, but none earned during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, they are eligible.

**Riders (on any horse/pony)** competing at 1.10m or above in any official British Showjumping or British Eventing competitions, or in Area, Regional or Championship Pony Club or Riding Club competitions are not eligible. Riders who have not participated in this level of competition during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's Sunshine Tour Championship, are eligible.

Combination cannot compete in Mini Tour show jumping.

# SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIPS

All horses and ponies competing in the Sunshine Tour Showing must not be professionally produced/trained for the show ring and must not be kept in training or livery (including DIY livery) with a professional / affiliated showing producer during the current year.

Each Showing Qualification Number allows you to enter one showing championship class.

**TOURS** are just groups of classes, divided by competence and measurable points/winnings restrictions - please respect the spirit of each level as well as the letter of the law. If you are outside the restrictions for the level that you qualified in, you can voluntarily move up to compete in a higher level. You CAN compete in BOTH Small & Grand Tour Showing if you fit the relevant restrictions.

#### **SMALL TOUR SHOWING**

# Horses/Ponies competing in Small Tour

- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **can** be registered with a showing or breed society but must **not** have won any affiliated class.
- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **cannot** have competed in any affiliated showing class at Royal International Horse Show, London International, Olympia or HOYS (from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 for Search for a Star).
- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **can** have taken part in preliminary qualifying rounds of classes that do not require pre-membership of the society but must **not** have taken part in second rounds or championships.

# **Riders/Handlers competing in Small Tour**

- Riders/handlers never to have competed in showing classes at Royal International Horse Show, London International, Olympia or HOYS and must not be involved with schooling, training, breaking, producing or breeding show horses/ponies.
- Cannot be currently listed on any showing panel and /or judge affiliated or unaffiliated showing classes; this restriction applies to paid or unpaid activities.
- Cannot teach others to ride, except in Riding School teaching clients not on their own horse/pony.
- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's championship; riders/handlers can have taken part
  in preliminary qualifying rounds of classes that do not require pre-membership of the society but must not have
  taken part in second rounds or championships.

#### **GRAND TOUR SHOWING**

#### **Horses/Ponies competing in Grand Tour**

- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **can** be registered with a showing or breed society and have been placed in first round competitions but must **not** have won a championship class.
- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **cannot** have competed in an affiliated showing class at Royal International Horse Show, London International, Olympia or HOYS (from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 for TSR HOYS Masterclass and Search for a Star).
- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to the date of this year's championship: horses/ponies **can** have taken part in second rounds of affiliated classes but must **not** have gone forward to the relevant final or championships.

# **Riders/Handlers competing in Grand Tour**

- During the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to the date of this year's championship: riders/handlers must **not** have competed in showing classes at Royal International Horse Show, London International, Olympia or HOYS and must not be professionally involved with schooling, training, breaking, producing, breeding or judging show horses/ponies.
- Cannot be currently listed on any affiliated showing panel and /or judge affiliated showing classes; this
  restriction applies to paid or unpaid activities. Cannot teach other to ride, except in Riding School teaching
  clients not on their own horse/pony.
