POSTAL ENTRIES FOR CHAMPIONSHIP & OPEN CLASSES accepted from 16th to 18th August.

You can post entries to us any time but entries will not be input until 16th August.



READ BEFORE ENTERING

1. **READ THE SCHEDULE BEFORE ENTERING!**
2. **It's your responsibility to only enter classes that the horse/pony & rider/handler are eligible to compete in**, see Rules for each discipline on the website www.sunshinetour.co.uk In-eligible combinations may have their entries cancelled.
3. **Recorded delivery** is advised for postal entries.
4. **Payment** is taken after your entry is accepted. Credit or debit card payment via phone call is required.
5. **Bookings are only accepted on an official entry form** - use official continuation sheet if your entry exceeds the first page. There is an **admin fee to pay per sheet of entries** - sorry, but it does take time to input paper entries onto computer.
6. **Quote the unique qualification code** for each championship class you are entering.
7. **First Aid is £4.50 per class.**
8. **If your class has sections**, please state clearly which section you are entering.
9. Accurate height of horse/pony and date of birth for juniors is required.
10. **Postal entries close Tuesday 18th August.** Some classes may fill before closing date. Qualification or registration is not a guarantee of your entry being accepted. If your class is full, there might be an alternative class to choose or join a waiting list.
11. **Withdrawals and amendments.** Withdrawals & amendments during initial entry period: no penalty. Withdrawals After Initial Closing Date: Withdrawals are only accepted for acute medical conditions and must be submitted in writing accompanied by a vet's or doctor's evidence. Period 1 - Wednesday 19th to Monday 24th August up to 75% refund; Period 2 - Tuesday 25th to Monday 31st August up to 50% refund; Period 3 – Tuesday 1st to Monday 7th September up to 25% refund; Period 4 – Tuesday 8th September onwards no refund for any reason. Medical evidence to apply for a partial refund must be received by 30th September following the current show. Amendments may be subject to £5.00 admin fee.
12. **Passports:** If staying overnight you must present your passport to Stable Manager when claiming your stable. Day competitors must have passports available for inspection by Security or Stewards in lorry parking area. Not required at ringside unless requested.
13. **You will need to provide your own 4-digit bridle disc.** Competitor numbers are published after entries close, this must be displayed clearly on your horse/pony's bridle at all times whilst on the showground, even for exercise or walking in-hand (does not apply in parking & stabling areas).
